

Need a Will or Codicil?

NEED A WILL?

Of course you do, so as to carry out your wishes.

HAVE YOU EVER THOUGHT

The people who inherit your estate if you die intestate (that means without a Will) will be determined by the Intestacy Rules under the Administration of Estates Act 1925 so who you want to have your property or money may not actually receive it. Also, if you die leaving a wife or husband and you do so intestate, the Intestacy Rules may not allow your wife or husband to receive the whole of your estate, instead a substantial amount could go to your children or even to your parents, brothers or sisters.

DO IT YOURSELF

You can of course buy a Will Form at a local shop and write out your own Will.

However, it will not save any time or money in the end and may well cause serious complications.

Remember, Solicitors make far more money sorting out the mistakes of home made Wills than they do from drawing up proper ones.

YES, YOU DO NEED A WILL

So why put it off any longer. Your friends or relatives may live to regret your hesitation.

THE COST

We charge £60.00 plus VAT for one Will and £90.00 plus VAT for two Wills e.g. for husband and wife or partners done at the same time.

A Codicil (to make a small change in an existing Will) costs £35.00 plus VAT or £45.00 for two done at the same time.
